ORDER

The Minister of Manitoba Infrastructure and Transportation is authorized

- (a) to enter into an agreement with the Government of Canada (Transport Canada) to cost share safety improvements at a railway crossing at Highway 13 near Oakville.

AUTHORITY

The Executive Government Organization Act, C.C.S.M. c. E170, states:

Agreements with other authorities

- 16 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may authorize a minister, for and on behalf of the government, or an agency of the government, to enter into an agreement with
- (a) the Government of Canada, or a minister or agency of the Government of Canada;

for the benefit or purposes of the residents of Manitoba or any part thereof.

BACKGROUND

1. The governments of Manitoba and Canada plan to contribute to the funding of an installation of an automated advanced warning system at Highway 13 (mileage and subdivision 42.09 Rivers).
2. Total costs for the project is anticipated at \$173,000 of which 80% or \$138,400 is recoverable from Transport Canada.
