ORDER

1. Corinne Stewart is appointed as Acting Resident Administrator for the Local Government District of Mystery Lake on an interim basis at a salary of \$87,111.44 per annum, which includes remoteness allowance.
2. The appointment is effective June 1, 2010.
3. Order in Council 208/2005 appointing Mr. John E. Burden as Resident Administrator is rescinded effective September 16, 2010.

AUTHORITY

The Local Government Districts Act, R.S.M. c. L190, states:

Appointment of officials and remuneration

9(4) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint

(a) a resident administrator for any one or more local government districts with such clerks and assistants as may be required to enable the resident administrator to carry out the resident administrator's duties; and

(b) such employees as may be required for all local government districts in the province;

and every person so appointed shall,

(c) as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, discharge the duties of, and hold, any office authorized by law;

(d) be under the control and direction of the minister; and

(e) be paid a salary or other remuneration as provided by law.

The Interpretation Act, C.C.S.M. c. 180, states:

Retroactive appointments

30 If an Act or regulation authorizes a person's appointment to a position, the document appointing the person may state that the appointment is effective on or after the day on which the person began performing the duties of the position.

BACKGROUND

No.

1. The previous Resident Administrator of the Local Government District of Mystery Lake retired on September 15, 2010, and utilized accrued vacation credits between June 1, 2010 and September 15, 2010.
2. A Memorandum of Understanding is in place for the Thompson Regional Airport Authority to take over operation of the Thompson Airport, which is currently under responsibility of the Local Government District of Mystery Lake. This transition is targeted to occur on January 1, 2011.
3. Corrine Stewart is currently the Assistant Resident Administrator and will assume the duties of Acting Resident Administrator on an interim basis until airport operations are formally transferred to the Thompson Regional Airport Authority in 2011.
