



MANITOBA ORDER IN COUNCIL

ORDER

- (a) Jim Derksen shall be appointed as a member and Vice-chair of the Accessibility Advisory Council (the Council).
- (b) The following shall be appointed as members of the Council:
- Diane Scribe Niiganii
 - Judy Redmond
 - Yvonne Peters
 - Doug Momotiuk
 - Lanny McInnes
 - Chris Summerville
 - Diane Driedger
 - Jim Baker
 - Scott Jocelyn
- (c) The terms of office of the Vice-chair and each member of the board appointed under this Order expires on August 23, 2014, and each continues to hold office until he or she is re-appointed, the appointment is revoked or a successor is appointed.
- (d) This Order comes into effect on September 1, 2011.

AUTHORITY

The Accessibility Advisory Council Act, C.C.S.M. c. A1.7, provides in part as follows:

Accessibility Advisory Council

4(1) The Accessibility Advisory Council is hereby established.

Appointment of members

4(2) The council is to consist of at least 6 and not more than 12 members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

First appointments

4(3) The Lieutenant Governor in Council must make the first appointments to the council within three months after the coming into force of this Act.

Members to be included

- 4(4) In appointing members to the council, the Lieutenant Governor in Council must include
- (a) persons who are disabled by barriers or representatives from organizations for persons who are disabled by barriers; and
 - (b) representatives of persons or organizations that have the ability to prevent and remove barriers that disable people.

Term of office

4(5) A member of the council is to be appointed for a term not exceeding three years.

Appointment continues

4(6) A member whose term expires continues to hold office until he or she is re-appointed, the appointment is revoked or a successor is appointed.

Chair and vice-chair.

4(7) The Lieutenant Governor in Council must designate one member of the council as chair and another member as vice-chair to act if the chair is absent or unable to act.

BACKGROUND

The Accessibility Advisory Act, which came into force on June 16, 2011, established a new Accessibility Advisory Council. The Lieutenant Governor in Council must make the first appointments to the council within three months after the coming into force of the Act.

When this Order is in effect, the Council will consist of the following members all of the City of Winnipeg:
